

ROBINETT, JAMES M. - Came to Texas in 1834, as is shown in the headright certificate issued to him July 17, 1838 for one-third of a league of land by the Board of Land Commissioners for Milam County. The land was surveyed in Leon County. He was issued a donation certificate No. ___ for 640 acres of land for having been detailed to guard the baggage at the camp opposite Harrisburg April 21, 1836. This was lost and a duplicate No. 493 was issued to him May 25, 1853. (?). Bounty Certificate No. 1229 was issued in Mr. Robinett's name December 28, 1838 for 640 acres of land due him for having served in the army from April 3 to October 13, 1836. He was living in Milam County, June 3, 1838 when he sold the rights to the certificate to John Teal for \$200.

The Deed Records of Leon County show Mr. Robinett living in Harris County July 22, 1851.
