

BREEDING, NAPOLEON BONAPARTE - Was issued Headright Certificate No. 41 for a league and labor of land January 19, 1838 by the Fayette County Board, in which it was stated that Mr. Breeding came to Texas in February, 1833. The certificate was lost and a duplicate was issued March 22, 1847.

Mr. Breeding was issued Donation Certificate No. 354, July 28, 1851 for 640 acres of land for having been detailed to guard the baggage at the camp opposite Harrisburg. He was living in Fayette County August 4, 1851 when he sold the certificate to James C. Gaither.

In 1843 Mr. Breeding was a member of the Snively Expedition.

Mr. Breeding was married to Charlotte O'Bar in Fayette County, January 19, 1838. He was living in Fayette County as late as January 28, 1853. (Deed Records of Fayette County, Book I, page 260)
