

CAMPBELL, JOHN - Born in 1818. He came to Texas in 1828 as is shown in the Headright Certificate issued to him August 2, 1838 for one third of a league of land by the Austin County Board. He is shown on page 41 of the army rolls in the General Land Office as one of the men of Company E, Captain Gibson Kuykendall, who was detailed to guard the baggage at the camp opposite Harrisburg, April 21, 1836. He was issued Bounty Certificate No. 9404 for 320 acres of land, October 14, 1841 for having served in the army from March 1 to May 30, 1836. He enlisted in Captain H. N. Cleveland's Company of Mill Creek Volunteers, July 1, 1836 and was issued Bounty Certificate No. 2603 for 320 acres of land, October 14, 1840 for serving in the army from July 1 to October 1, 1836.

Mr. Campbell was a member of the Texas Veterans Association at the time of his death in Austin in 1888.
