BARCINES, ANDREIS - Born in Texas, as is stated in the Headright
Certificate issued to him February 1, 1838 for one-third of a league
of land. He was a member of Captain Juan N. Seguin's Company at San
Jacinto and on May 26, 1846 his heirs were issued Donation Certificate
No. 32 for 640 acres of land due him for having participated in the
battle. On December 21, 1837 he received Bounty Certificate No. 1231
for 1280 acres of land due him for his services from March 1, 1836
to June 1, 1837. The heirs on June 6, 1846 received Bounty Certificate
No. 73 for 1280 acres for his services in the army from November 5,
1837 to March 1, 1838, when he died. Colonel Jual N. Seguin was
appointed administrator of his estate in Bexar County, May 27, 1839.
