

PEVEHOUSE, PRESTON - Born in Arkansas, _____, 1815. He came to Texas in January, 1833, as is shown in Headright Certificate No. 77 issued to him February 3, 1838 for one-third of a league of land by the Fort Bend County Board. He was issued Donation Certificate No. 336 for 640 acres of land, June 20, 1838 for having participated in the Storming and Capture of Bexar, December 5 to 10, 1835, at which he was wounded. On June 14, 1838 he received Bounty Certificate No. 3852 for 320 acres of land for having served in the army from November 13, 1835 to February 10, 1836.

Mr. Pevehouse was third corporal in Captain Peyton R. Splans's company in 1836, and was among those detailed to guard the baggage at the camp opposite Harrisburg, April 21, 1836. He was living in Austin County March 18, 1853, probably in that part now embraced in Waller county. In 1874 he was a member of the Texas Veterans Association and was living in Milam County.
