FUNLER, STYLES J. - Arrived in Texas in December, 1835, as is stated in the headright certificate issued April 23, 1838 in the name of <u>Stiles J. Fowler</u>, deceased, for one third of a league of land by the Board of Land Commissioners for Harrisburg County. James Morgan was the administrator of his estate.

Mr. Fowler was a member of Captain Moseley Baker's San Felipe Company at San Jacinto and on February 17, 1849 Donation Certificate No. 150 was issued in the name of Styles Fowler, due him for having participated in the battle. Bounty Certificate No. 502 for 640 acres of land was issued in the name of Styles Fowler, February 17, 1849, due him for his services in the army from March 31 to September 29, 1836. The land was surveyed in Hays County for Mr. Fowler's heirs.
