BATEMAN, WILLIAM On applying for a Headright Certificate for one third of a league of land to the Board of Land Commissioners of San Augustine County, June 22, 1838, Mr. Bateman stated that he arrived in Texas in 1835. The land was surveyed in Red River County in 1838. He received Bounty Certificate No. 514 for 320 acres of land for serving in the army from March 15 to June 15, 1836. The land was surveyed in the Denton Land District in 1854. He was a member of Captain William Kimbro's Company at San Jacinto and on March 27, 1847 was issued Donation Certificate No. 154 for 640 acres of land for having participated in the battle.
