Asberry $\mathbb{M}_{0 \text { g }}$ a carpenter, arrived at Volasco, Janaruy 28. 1836, on the Behooner Pennuylvania, having been recruited in New Ore 2eanm for the arny of cexam by Gaptain Anama Turner. on page 10 of the San Jacinto rolle printed in 1336 ho 1 . licted as M. Snvdos a corporal in Gaptain Turner"a Cotupany of Regulars.

He. Snyder loft Tezas shortiy after being discharged from the arry without applying for the land due him. On Octobers 8, 1850, he was 1smued Donation Cortificate No. 229 Por 640 acres of land for having participated in the battle of San Jacinto. On November $20_{0}$ 1850, he was 1spued Bounty Cortiricate No. 713 for 1280 acres of land for having sexved in the aryy for apertod of one yoas or more. The dato of anlistment or discharge is not ahown in the owripicate. Ho did not apply for the land due him as a hoadright.

In the Deod Records of Boxar County it is shown that Mr. Snycer and hia wifo Hary Ann Syylor wore living in Baltmore, Harymand, Jano uary 1.1852 , when they mold their land in Texas.

At the promotion of Captain Tuzner to Lieutonant Colonel. the men of his company were transicxred to Company $A$. Fixat Rogicmen of Eogulampermanded by Captail in John shith. On page 172 of the mugtere sol2g in the General Land 0sfioo Mr. Snyder in ghom am a manbur of Captain $S_{\text {rastic }}{ }^{\circ}$ Company Decerber $31_{2}$ 1836, shtiloned on Galveaton Island. He 15 shown as heving anlisted in the arry Fobruary 10 1836, for a 色酸 of two Joars. He was promoted to Corporal liarch 27, to

Sorge nt June 9 and resignod as Sergeant Novamber 13th。On Decone ber31. 1836, he was on dotached aexvice on board the achooner Apoing. At the mastare of the Company Febuary 28,1837 Mr. Snyder in again. on page 181. Bhown on cetached sexvice on board the Apol19\%.

Mr. Snyder roturned to Texas and died monowhero in the state two or three yearg after the divil War. A daughter of his Mra. Lizaio Burdstt, and a brother-in-law, C. V. Fuck, were living in Baltimores Maryland, Hovember $2,1599$.

The rollowing notes wore made by Dro V. O. Kinge
"On page 18 of this Report Dr . King makes a note to the mane of Corporal ${ }^{4}$. Snyder saying: "His full name was Abbuyy MeKondree Syyione accordine to his daughter, Mrs. Lizzie Burditt, and his brothorilnLaw C. V. Fuick, Baltimore, Maryland, who writes ne Mo. 1899. See his Lottor Higt. Arch. No. 66. He says Snydor! sather was Mathsas Snyder, was bom in Alexandria, $V$. 1816, was a earpontor, come to Texas In 1835-36. Returned to Beltimore after the Toxam Wasp and again wont to Texas, where he died 2 or 3 years aftor the Civil waso"
