

WATKIN, JAMES E. - Arrived in Texas in 1835 and on September 14th of that year he was issued a certificate of Character of Radford Berry, Alcalde of Nacogdoches, in which it was stated that he was single. On January 14, 1839 he was issued Bounty Certificate No. 7011 for 320 acres of land for having served in the army from February 27 to May 27, 1836. This he assigned to Ralph Jacobs, January 14, 1839. He was a member of Captain Moseley Baker's San Felipe Company at San Jacinto but he did not apply for the donation land due him for having participated in the battle. Neither did he apply for a headright.
