Hormani, thomas - Born January 18, 1819. In Headright Certifieate No. 132 issued in 2838 in the name of Thomas Nomant, deceased for one-third of a league of land by the Board of Land Comassionera for Liberty County it is stated that Mr. Norment oame to Texas in 1831.

The father and mother of Wh. Worment had the following children. Maxy, born Jamary 7, 1815; married to Dr. Nicholas D. Labadie; died November 5, 1839. Sarah, born January 18, 1819 and died December 1. 1835, unnarried. William, born March 10, 1821 and died October 21, 1836 while in the United States Arry. He was single。

Mr. Norment, the father died and in due time his widow was marsiea to Willian Johns. Dr. Nicholas D. Labadie writing in the Texas Alamanac of 2859 , page 40 , stated that the company coumanded by captain William K. Logan at San Jacinto was organized at the home of Mre. William Johns, "the son of Mrs, Johns, Thomas Morman, and the writer were the only two men from that neighborhood (Anahuac). 0thers were Beausint and IL, berty boys."

Thomas Noment re-enlisted July 7, and served until October 7. 1836 in Captain Frankinn Kiardin's Company. As has been stated, he aiea Decamber $1,2838$.

Hir. Norment was issued Bounty Certificate No. 3462 for 640 acres of land May 19, 1838 sor having served in the army from Mareh 6 to Qetober 7, 1836.

On December 28, 2841 Donation Certificate No. 1189 for 640 acres of land was issued in Mr. Noment's naree, due him for having been
detailed to guard the baggage at the camp opposite Karrisburg April $122,1836$.
