NASH, JAMES H. -- Listed on page 22 of the army rolls in the General Land Office as James Nash, a member of Captain Chesshire's Company before Bexar in 1835. On page 1 of the rolls James Nash is shown as having enlisted in Captain Byrd Lockhart's Company February 23, 1836.
