PARKCBR, DICKIREON - The compiler is responsible for having the name Dickinson Parker put on the bronge placqe in the menorial towar on the San Jacinto battiefiela and on the monument erected at the grave of Mr. Paricer in Houston County. Altho the name Dickinson Paxker appears on the official $\mathrm{San}_{\mathrm{g}} J_{a c i n t o}$ rolls printed in a booklet in 1836 the correct name is Diokgrson Parkers.

My. Parker was born in Tennessee, thay 29, 1812, a son of Reverond Daniel and Patsey (Dickerson) Parker. On June 9, 1835 he recelved title to one-fourth of a leagte of land in Burnet's Colonys situated in the present county of Anderson. In the headright certificate ism sued to Dickerson Parker Pebruary 15. 1838 Ior three-fourths of a leam gue and one labor of land by the Bord of Land Comaissioners for Houston Gounty it is gtated that he eane to Texas in 1833. Mro Parkell was a member of Captain Haydon Arnold's Hagontoches Company at the battle of San Jacinto and on Noveraber 18, 1839 Donation Certiricate No. 948 for 640 acres of land was issued in the name of Dicigerson Parker, deu him for having particip ted in the battle. Bounty Gertificate No. 9298 for 320 acres of land was issued on the same date to Digkerson Parker, due him for having served in the army from Marok \& to iiky 30 , 1836.

Mr. Parikers was mamiod to Lucinda Eaton Uotober 1, 1837. Hr. Paricer died August 2, 1844. Hrs. Pariker was born Jenuary 14, 1820 and died January 27, 1847. The State of Texas had a joint monusent erected at their graves in tho Parker fanily cemetery near Hikhart, Houston County in 2936.
