THE SAN JACINTO MONUMENT, at just under 570 feet, is one of the finest examples of Moderne (Art Deco) architecture in the United States. Today, the world's tallest war memorial provides a historically rich and unique location to host the party of the century or an intimate gathering. Each event space sets the scene for your corporate receptions, weddings, or non-profit fundraisers.

The battlefield offers a serene backdrop to make your next event one to remember. From the grand oak trees to the Reflection Pool, you and your guests will be surrounded by history. The spacious grounds can accommodate small to large groups without feeling crowded.









Located inside the Monument, the museum lobby and exhibit halls surround guests with over 500 years of history.

The room features Texas Cordova shell-stone walls and terrazzo floors. You can host up to 100-120 for a seated or 100-160 for a standing reception. The lobby is ideal for wedding receptions, corporate events, military retirements and more.









The Jesse H. Jones Theatre, located within the Monument, offers state-of-the-art audiovisual capabilities, theatrical staging, dynamic lighting, and impeccable sound systems.

With 18 rows of tiered seating accommodating 156 guests, along with four wheelchair-accessible spaces, it presents an ideal choice for film screenings, live performances, presentations, and more. Our dedicated facility rentals staff is on-site throughout your event to manage audio-visual systems and ensure a seamless experience for your film or presentation.

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VENUE RENTAL FAQ

HOW DO I BOOK AN EVENT AT THE MUSEUM?

We are happy to place a courtesy hold on your preferred date on a first come, first serve basis while you are in the initial planning stages for your event. If another party requests the same date, you will have two business days to move to contract and pay the deposit or release the space. To secure the date, a signed Rental Agreement and 20% deposit of the agreement total are required. The remaining balance is due 7-business days prior to the event date.

WHEN ARE THE RENTAL SPACES AVAILABLE?

The Monument Lobby and Theatre are available Wednesday-Sunday between 6:00 pm – 12:00 am. Special consideration will be granted for events needing to start during operating hours. All rentals are provided with an additional 4-hours to setup and 1-hour to clean up.

The San Jacinto Museum is closed to the public on Mondays and Tuesdays but remain available all day for private events.

WHAT TIME CAN SETUP START?

Standard access to the Museum and loading area for all vendors and clients is 4-hours before the event start time on the day of the event. Vendors and clients are asked to be respectful of Museum guests and maintain a low volume until the Museum closes to the public at 6:00 pm. If additional load in time is needed, early load in requires pre-approval from the events manager.

IS EXHIBITION ACCESS INCLUDED?

Exhibit access is included with rental spaces.

WHAT SERVICES ARE OFFERED?

Our rental rates include an onsite event coordinator that will assist you and your vendors with building access and organization, oversee the event's set up and break down, and be available throughout the event to ensure the entire process runs smoothly. Please keep in mind that we do not provide full event planning services.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE RENTAL RATES?

The base Museum rental rate does not include catering, equipment rentals, liability insurance, audio and visual services, decor, entertainment, or outside vendors. The San Jacinto Events team does not provide full service planning, but can provide support and insight throughout the process. Though not required, the Events team recommends and encourages working with a professional event planner for weddings and other significant celebrations.

DOES THE MUSEUM REQUIRE INSURANCE?

Yes, the Museum requires all vendors to provide a certificate of liability insurance, with the museum named as additional insured, at least 30 days prior to the event. Clients are not required to provide a certificate of insurance.

WHAT IF I NEED TO RESCHEDULE MY EVENT?

You have the flexibility to reschedule an event up to 30 days prior to the contracted date. Within 30 days of the event, there is a \$250.00 rescheduling fee, and the date change must be approved first by San Jacinto Events Staff and made official through a contract amendment.

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VENUE RENTAL FAQ

DOES THE MUSEUM HAVE PREFERRED VENDORS?

Yes, the Museum has a list of preferred catering companies for clients to choose from and a list of approved AV vendors. There are no restrictions on other vendor services and our team is happy to provide you with names of vendors who have worked in the Museum before and delivered professional service to their clients. Please note that vendors must be approved by San Jacinto Events Staff at least 2 weeks prior to the event date.

CAN WE USE AN OUTSIDE CATERER OR WORK WITH A CATERER NOT ON YOUR LIST?

Yes, you can use an outside caterer for your event. Caterers are required to provide a certificate of insurance and attend final walkthrough. Caterers are responsible for any cleanup associated with the services and setup including emptying trash receptacles after the event.

CAN WE PROVIDE OUR OWN ALCOHOL?

All alcoholic beverage services must be handled by a caterer, bar service or TABC certified bartender, in accordance with Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission laws. Outside alcohol is permitted on the premises and must be served behind the designated bar. Bar service must conclude 30 minutes before the event end time. Alcohol-only events are not be permitted.

CAN WE STORE ANYTHING OVERNIGHT?

The Museum has limited storage space and no items may be delivered in advance of load in or left in the Museum overnight after an event, unless approved by the event manager.

SECURITY

At least two security officers will be provided during your event to keep guests safe.

ENTERTAINMENT

You are able to have a DJ or live band during your event. They are required to bring their own speakers, special lighting, and equipment.

CAN WE HOST A WEDDING CEREMONY REHEARSAL?

A one-hour wedding ceremony rehearsal is included in the wedding rental rate and must be pre-arranged with San Jacinto Events Staff. Rehearsals must conclude by 5:30 pm.

WHAT IS THE MUSEUM'S PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY?

A two-hour photo session is available to all wedding clients. The client must provide their own photographer and prearrange the date and time for the photoshoot with San Jacinto Event Staff. Personal use photography is allowed in rental and exhibition spaces. Any professional photography and other inquiries should be directed to the Event Manager

DOES THE MUSEUM HAVE PARKING?

Free parking is available to guests adjacent to the Monument the day of the event. Parking is subject to availability and capacity.
