We are looking for exhibitors and entertainers who can showcase Texas-themed items or activities. Examples include displays of historical weapons used in Texas and wood-carving or quilting demonstrators. Entertainment examples include singing, square-dancing, and storytelling.

Electrical:

There are no electrical outlets/hook-ups available in the Park. Vendors are responsible for their own electrical. You will be allowed to bring generators for your booth.

Decorations:

Pop-up canopies will be provided if you need them. A banner with your company's name will be attached to the tent. All booth vendors/exhibitors are encouraged to decorate booths and dress in the Texas or period theme. No items bearing the words San Jacinto Day Festival and/or San Jacinto Museum/Monument or its logos will be allowed without the prior approval of the San Jacinto Day Festival Committee. No audio speakers to broadcast information or music will be allowed in or outside of allotted booth space area. **No golf carts or 4-wheelers of any kind will be allowed by anyone except the San Jacinto Day Festival Committee and/or Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.**

Sales and promotions:

In the case of drawings, all prizes must be given away during the Festival and must be approved through the San Jacinto Day Festival Office prior to the Festival. Also, a list of all winners must be turned into the Festival Office.

All sales and promotions must be conducted inside the exhibitor's booth space, not in the visitor walkway, in front of the booth or walking around the Festival grounds. All equipment must be inside the exhibitor's allotted booth space and must not encroach into the walkways.

The San Jacinto Day Festival Committee reserves the right to prohibit sales or distribution of any and all printed or other items, which may be considered objectionable or offensive to the organization or the public.

Fee Information:

Vendors wishing to reserve a space must return the completed application along with the TOTAL amount no later than **April 1, 2008**. Space is limited. No personal checks will be accepted. Company checks from prior year vendors, money orders and credit cards (Mastercard, Visa, Discover and American Express only) will be accepted.
