HOLLINGSWORTH, JAMES - Came to Texas previous to May 2, 1835, as is stated in Headright Certificate No. 356 issued to him February 20, 1838 for one-twelfth of a league of land by the Board of Land Commissioners for Washington County. In Comptroller's Military Record No. 4329 it is certified that Mr. Hollingsworth served in Captain William W. Hill's Company from March 1 to May 30, 1836. He was issued Donation Certificate No. 864 for 640 acres of land, May 3, 1839 for having been detailed to guard the baggage at the camp opposite Harrisburg, April 21, 1836.

The probate records of Burleson County show that Mr. Hollingsworth died in that county in 1850. Mrs. Rachael Hollingsworth was appointed administratrix of his estate, March 2, 1850.
