MARSHALL, HUGH LEWIS - Born July 25, 1313. On page 42 of the army rolls in the General Land Office as one of the men of Company E, Captain Gibson Kuykendall, who were detailed to guard the baggage at the camp opposite Harrisburg, April 21, 1836. On page ____ of the rolls he is shown as a member of Captain H. N. Cleaveland's company of Mill Creek Volunteers at muster July 1, 1836.

Mr. Marshall died March 19, 1891 and is buried in a marked grave in the Griffin Cemetery two miles west of the town of Little River Bell County.

Mrs. Bird Reed Farrant, 1619 Seevers Avenue, Dallas, is a granddaughter of Hugh L. Marshall.
