He did not apply for donation land. On page __ of the army rolls he is shown as a member of Captain H. N. Cleveland's company of Mill Creek Volunteers when the company was mustered __ 1836. He was issued Bounty Certificate No. 1789 for 640 acres of land January 12, 1838 for having served in the army from March 1 to October 1, 1836.
