PRICE, WILLIAM - Come to Texas in 1832, as is shown in Headright Certificate No. 46 issued to him for one-third of a league of land,

January 18, 1838 by the Austin County Board of Land Commissioners.

He was a member of Captain Gibson Kuykendall's Company and on September 18, 1838 he was issued Bounty Certificate No. 4313 for 320 acres of land for having served in the army from March 1 to May 30, 1836.

He received Domation Certificate No. 545 for 640 acres of land September 18, 1838 for having been detailed to gu ard the baggage at the camp opposite Harrisburg.

On an army roll in the General Land Office Mr. Price is shown as having enlisted in Captain Benjamin F. Reavill's Company, July 1, 1836.

Mr. Price was living in Bexar County, March 5, 1850 when he sold land (Book I, page 138, Deed Records of Bexar County)
