ARREOLA, SIMÓN. -- Born in Texas, as was stated by him on February 2, 1838, when he appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners of Bexar County and applied for a head-right certificate for a league and labor of land. He was a member of Captain Juan N. Seguin's Company at San Jacinto and on May 1, 1854, Donation Certificate No. 574 for 640 acres of land was issued in his name, due him for having participated in the battle. On September 29, 1837, he sold his rights to the land he was entitled to receive for having served in the army from February 23 to July 31, 1836.

Bounty Certificate No. 2370 was issued in his name on February 14, 1838, for 320 acres of land for the services mentioned.

In the Deed Records of Bexar County, Book 2, page 550, it is stated that on November 2, 1850, Mr. Arreola "was either dead or out of the state."

Mrs. Guadalupe Arreola, widow of Simón Arreola, was living in Guadalupe County May 11, 1880, when she received a Veteran's Donation Certificate for 1280 acres of land.
