BANKS, RIBASON - Born in Baldwin County, Georgia, a son of Soloman and Jane Banks. In the Court of Claims files in theGeneral Land Office is on affidavit made by Robert Micllejohn of Baldwin County, Georgia, in behalf of James B. Murphy whose heirs had applied for the land due him for his services in the army of Texas. He stated that in the year 1835 the following young men left Beldwin County for Mason, Bibb County, Georgia, where they were enlisted in the ammy of Texas by William Word: James. B. Murphy, John Spillers, Lowis Washington, Joseph M. Buchannan, Reason Banks, Robert Darnell, Green B. Buchannan and James Calk.

19x. Banks arrived at Velasco December 20, 1835, as a member of Gaptain James C. Winn's Company of the Ceorgia Battalion. His name appears on page 12 of the army rolls in the General Land Office as a former member of Captain winn's Comoany who had left on Ja uary 8, 1836, "with a public rifle." He joined Gaptain William S. Fisher's Company of Velasco Blues and as a member of that organization fought at San Jacinto, for which on July 2,1855 , he received Donation Certifieate No. 980 for 640 acres of Land. On April 9, 1838, he recaived Bounty Certificate No, 2807 for 320 acres of land for havIng served in the army from Maxch 3 to June 3, 1836.

In a Comptroller's Military Service Record in the Archives of the Fexas State Library, Richard Bache, Chief Clerk of the War Departient, wrote: I certify that it appears from the muster roll of Captain Vinn's Company, Georgia Volunteers, 1st. Regiment, Texas $^{\text {P }}$ Volunteers, that he (Banks) served from 3lst December to 8th January,

1836, when it appears he deserted, but the Secretary of War having reinstatea him and he was returned through misapprehension. I certify that he was entitied to pay from December 29,1835 to February 13, $1836^{n}$

Solorran B. Banks ated in Baldwin County, Georgia, in 1849 and Trs. Banks died these in 1861. Their children in order of birth were Blizabeth, who married John A. Robertson; Saxah, who married Claiborne Buckner; Reason, who never married; and Luraney Banks who married William Kelley.

Mr. and Mrs. Milliam Kelley moved to Grimes County, Mexas, and for a number of years Mr. Reason Banks Lived at their home. He returned to Georgia in 1882 and aied there in 1885.

Children of Mr. and Mrs. William Kelley were (1) Sarah Jane, (2) W. D. Kelley, (3) Solomon, (4) Kilzabeth and (5) Kstharine Kelley.
(1) Sarah Jane Kelley was married to W. L. Campbell and a daughter of this union, Liflian, was married to G. Brown Kennard. Mr. and Mrs. Kennard live in Anderson, Texas.
