TAYLOR, JOHN B. - Arrived in Texas in May, 1831, as is shown in Headright Certificate No. 154 issued to him February 12, 1838 for one-thrid of a league of land by the Montgomery County Board of Land Commissioners.

Im Comptroller's Military Service Record No. 8352 it is certified that he served in Captain John York's Company at the Sterming and Capture of Bexar, December 5 to 19, 1935; reenlisted March 13, and served until June 2, 1836 and was a member of Captain William H. Patton's Company at San Jacinto. It is also stated that he served in Captain Washington H. Secrest's Company of Washington Cavalry from June 30, to October 23, 1830.

Mr. Taylor did not apply for the bounty and donation land due him for his services in the army. He was living in Montgomery County November 5, 1842 when he sold his headright certificate to Henry Fant hrop for \$200.00.
