Join us at this Inaugural Event benefitting the San Jacinto Museum of History

The San Jacinto Battleground is home of the San Jacinto Memorial Monument and the San Jacinto Museum of History. The event is sponsored by the San Jacinto Museum of History which is a 501(c) 3. The San Jacinto Battleground State Historic Site is located off the Houston Ship Channel at One Monument Circle La Porte, Texas 77571.

We invite all RVers to join us on this one-night for boondocking around the monument. As with traditional boondocking, there will be no electric or water hook-ups. Generators must be used. For your convenience, there will be porta-potties stationed around the camping area. There will be no assigned parking and slots will be assigned based on arrival times beginning at 5 p.m. on the 20th. Registration begins now until all slots are sold. There will only be 100 camping slots sold to this event. Register early. No tent camping available at this event.

Come for a full evening of history, great food, music, crafts for the kids and plenty of room for bicycling on the 1,200 acres site. Participants are encouraged to explore the battlefield, enjoy history inside the museum and ride the elevator to the top of the monument. Few get to see the Houston skyline from this vantage point – do not miss this opportunity. The special exhibit, *A Monumental Experience* is also available. There will some firepits available onsite- so bring your camp chairs and gather round. There is plenty of room for social distancing. New activities will be added as the event gets closer so check the website often to get updates.

Admission includes two adult BBQ dinners. Additional meals can be purchased – see registration page. Breakfast will be served for a small fee on the 21th from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m.

Don't miss the movie showing in the IMAX style theatre with a 165-seat capacity (80 for COVID) located inside the monument. For our little campers the movie TBD will begin showing at TBD. Kids bring your pillows and bag snacks- no drinks inside the theater.
