Boondocking Etiquette

1. Leave nothing behind upon departure. Pack it in. Pack it out.
2. For the courtesy of other guests please bring "quiet" generators.
3. Park only in designated areas. Parking will be based on arrival time.
4. Dogs are allowed. Keep pets on a leash. No pets allowed inside the Monument.

Site Amenities

1. Porta Potties will be placed throughout the perimeter of the RV parking area.
2. Attended fire rings will be placed within the surrounding green space.
3. RV parking will be in the circular drive surrounding the monument.
4. No tent camping is available at this event.
5. Picnic tables will be placed around the monument exterior green space.
6. The San Jacinto Museum of History doors will remain open to participants all night.
