PARK, WILLIAM A. -- In the headright certificate issued to Mr. Park in 1838 by the Board of Land Commissioners for Red River County it is stated that Mr. Park had arrived in Texas December 20, 1835. In Comptroller's Military Service Record No. 4234 it is certified that he enlisted in Captain Peyton R. Splane's Company, March 20th and served in it until April 14th when he was transferred to Captain Isaac N. Moreland's Company of artiller. He was wounded at San Jacinto and was discharged from the army May 3, 1836. On November 30, 1839 he was issued Donation Certificate No. 965 for 640 acres of land for having participated in the Battle of San Jacinto and Bounty Certificate No. 9325 for 320 acres for having served in the army from March 20 to May 3, 1836.

Mr. Park was living in Red River County, July 26, 1853 when he sold Bounty Certificate No. 9325 for \$80.00.
